STATE MINIMUM WAGE INCREASES JANUARY 1ST

Please remember that in 2016 California passed legislation to increase the State minimum wage to \$15 per hour over time. Under the provisions of that law, California's minimum wage will increase on January 1, 2019 to \$12 per hour for employers with 26 employees or more and \$1.00 for employers with 25 or fewer employees.

On December 14, 2018, the IRS issued the 2019 standard optional rates used calculate to the deductible costs of operating an automobile for charitable. business. medical or moving Beginning purposes. January 1, 2019. standard mileage rates fo the use of a car (also vans, pickups, and/or other panel trucks) is \$0.58 per mile (up from \$0.545 in 2018). Read more here.


